<p>Nomination & Application process</p>	<p>Nominations must be sent to: ecole@lareunion-archi.fr before :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the 15th of April (Fall term) - the 15th of October (Spring term) <p>Application forms must be sent to ecole@lareunion-archi.fr before :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the 20th of May (Fall term) - the 20th of November (Spring term) <p>The application form is to be accompanied by a transcript of records, the Learning agreement, a portfolio, a letter of motivation and official proof of B1 French level. The letter should mention language courses taken or to be taken. An online interview will be organized to test the student's language level.</p> <p>Incoming applications will be reviewed and admission confirmed as rapidly as possible following the deadline.</p>
<p>European Credit Transfer System</p>	<p>60 ECTS credits per year: 1st term = 30 ECTS credits; 2nd term = 30 ECTS credits.</p> <p>Workload for one ECTS credits: 30h (classwork + student's individual work/study).</p>
<p>Enrolment</p>	<p>Students must enroll upon arrival, two weeks before the beginning of the semester.</p> <p>They must provide photocopy of passport or ID card, photocopy of European health card or equivalent, and any other required documents according to their particular situation.</p> <p>Amendments to the proposed learning agreement are possible 2 weeks after arrival and will be sent to the home university for approval.</p>
<p>Non-European students</p>	<p>Visiting students from outside the European Union should contact the local French Embassy or Consulate, in order to fulfil requirements for a student visa.</p>
